Show Rules:

1. Age Groups: Performance Horses – Junior, Ages 5 & Under; Performance Horses – Senior, Ages 6 & Over
Youth & Amateur – Exhibitor’s Age as of January 1, 2012; Date of Birth must be written on entry form
2. Each exhibitor **MUST** show a current APHA membership card to the show secretary. A replacement membership card may be purchased at the show.
3. Novice Amateurs and Amateurs **MUST** show 2012 Amateur Card to show secretary at each show and cannot show horses that they do not own in accordance with APHA Rule AM-020.A. **Must have copy of transferred papers in hand to show.** Temporary card may be purchased at the show.
4. Novice Youth **MUST** show 2012 card to show secretary at each show. (YP-210). Temporary card may be purchased at the show.
5. Per Show Management, there must be 2 points to be had on either side of the “classic and/or master”; otherwise the class will be combined.

WALK-TROT, 13 & UNDER, 14-18, NOVICE YOUTH, NOVICE AMATEUR, CLASSIC AMATEUR & MASTER AMATEUR ALL AROUND

To qualify for these awards, horse/rider combination must be shown in *respective halter* class and 3 performance events.
