**Crossover Fee:** Once a horse has maxed out in a division (paid the \$160 all day fee), that horse may crossover to ALL eligible divisions with no additional entry fee.  
**Practice Trail** – Each Trail horse will be charged \$10 for unlimited practice  
**Practice Over Fence** – Each Over Fence horse will be charged \$10 for unlimited practice  
**Office charge:** \$48 per horse **Stalls/Grounds Fee:** \$25 per horse per day  
**RV:** RV space, first come first serve **Shavings:** Through the facility, paid separately  
**Reining Jackpots:** \$\$ All Amateur & Open will be Jackpotted (included in entry fee) - \$47 per class (\$10 jackpot +\$5 to PPHSS finals)

**All-Around for Open Division** Horse must be shown in *open halter* and 3 performance events in 3 different categories. (Rule SC-145.A)

### Show Rules:

1. Age Groups: Performance Horses – Junior, Ages 5 & Under; Performance Horses – Senior, Ages 6 & Over Youth & Amateur – Exhibitor's Age as of January 1, 2012; Date of Birth must be written on entry form
2. Each exhibitor **MUST** show a current APHA membership card to the show secretary.
3. Novice Amateurs and Amateurs **MUST** show 2012 Amateur Card to show secretary at each show and cannot show horses that they do not own in accordance with APHA Rule AM-020.A. **Must have copy of transferred papers in hand to show.** Temporary card may be purchased at the show.
4. Novice Youth **MUST** show 2012 card to show secretary at each show. (YP-210). Temporary card may be purchased at the show.
5. Per Show Management, there must be 2 points to be had on either side of the "classic and/or master"; otherwise the class will be combined per AM-080.B.
6. 12 Month Coggins Required –
7. APHA, & TPHC approved for points
